

Berkshire Senior Team Selection

- 1.** There will be a Squad Selection shoot organised at the start of each outdoor shooting season. It will be a 12 dozen round (either a Ladies/Gents FITA or York/Hereford (method of timing to be determined depending on Team match programme)) and the results will form the basis of the squad rankings list for that year. Archers will be invited to attend (all archers will be able to access the entry form from the website). If they do not come to the squad selection then they will not be shooting for the county that year unless they submit three scores to the Match Secretary (scores must come from open tournaments and the average handicap of the three scores will form the basis for the initial ranking).
- 2.** The senior squad rankings list may include Junior Archers provided they qualify by shooting the adult rounds.
- 3.** Once the squad list has been established, archers will submit their scores to the Match Secretary. Only 12 dozen rounds will be accepted, and may only come from open shoots or rounds shot on recognised club target days. Scores must be submitted using the form on the website. It will be the archers' responsibility to submit their own scores. In the case of rounds shot at the club, the relevant club records officer will be asked by the Match Secretary to verify the score.
- 4.** 2 months before the date of any match the Match Secretary will organise a squad session for the top 10 archers for each discipline and gender from the list of those available for matches. The Match Secretary will immediately select the teams for the next event. (The actual method of selection needs to be determined...)
- 5.** In the case of the Southern Counties Inter-Counties Team Championships, a team of 6 Recurve and 6 Compound Archers will be selected, with at least two from each gender, if possible.
- 6.** Squad details, ranking lists, target lists and results will appear on the County website under "Berkshire Team".

Junior Team:

For the Junior Team, other factors are included for team selection, such as birthdays and age-group changes. Junior Team selection will continue to be based on projected scores using their current handicap rounds.

Berkshire Top Ten

Club Records Officers must continue to send everyone's scores to the County Record's Officer so that the overall rankings lists may continue.
